NOTICE OF THE CLOSURE OF C2056 THE NASH, KEMPSEY, WORCESTERSHIRE
("THE HIGHWAY")

Reason for restriction: Surface dressing. There is a need to close the highway in the following terms:-

1. The effect of this Notice is that no vehicle shall proceed along that part of the highway from its junction with A38 Main Road for a distance of 1150 metres in an easterly direction.
2. This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 5 days, however, it is anticipated that it will remain in force for 3 days commencing 9 September 2024.
3. Alternative routes: - C2056 Kerswell Green, C2056 Kerswell Green to High Green, C2105 Quay Lane to High Green, C2203 Quay Lane, C2203 Church Lane, A4104 Pershore Road, A38 Worcester Road, A38 Severn Stoke Bank, A38 Severn Stoke, A38 Sandford, A38 Clifton, A38 Main Road and vice versa.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
