NOTICE OF THE CLOSURE OF U60007 STONEHALL COMMON, KEMPSEY, WORCESTERSHIRE ("THE HIGHWAY")

Reason for restriction: Burst water main. There is a likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road. There is a need to close the highway in the following terms:-

- 1. The effect of this Notice is that no vehicle shall proceed along that part of the highway from its junction with C2108 Wadborough Road to its junction with C2202 Hill Road.
- 2. This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 21 days; however, it is anticipated that it will remain in force for 3 days (24hrs) commencing 20 May 2025.
- 3. Alternative routes: C2108 Wadborough Road, C2209 Abbots Wood, C2209 Station Road, C2109 Sidings Road to Station Road, C2109 Sidings Road, C2109 Pirton to Croome D'Abitot, U47621 Pirton Court, C2202 Worcester Road and vice versa.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
