

Kempsey Parish / PACT meeting report:

The figures displayed below represents the time frames of 31st August 2025 to 16th November 2025. For a good representation of the figures, the total number have been divided by the month they have occurred in.

(A factor to the ASB figures being significantly higher than the last report will be based on the ASB reporting process. For example, vehicle nuisance, neighbour disputes and parking concerns will be recorded as Anti-Social Behaviour)

The increase in ASB figures compared to previous reports is largely due to a wider range of incidents being classified as Anti-Social Behaviour. This adjustment provides a more accurate and transparent picture of what is happening within the village, help us better understand and address local concerns. The incidents classified as Anti-Social Behaviour are incidents which are non-crime related. We understand certain incident such as criminal damage, public order etc also may also involve elements of anti-social behaviour.

Since the last report, we have undergone some changes in team personnel. Unfortunately, we say goodbye to PC Jon HAND who is joining a different department in West Mercia Police. However, we welcome PC Smith and PCSO Emeny who join the team permanently. They join PC Stanley and PCSO Smith who remain on the team. As such, the team now has 2 Safer Neighbourhood Officers and 2 Police Community Support Officers.

The team remains committed to addressing the concerns raised by the community. One key issue continues to be the parking challenges throughout the village, particularly during school drop-off and collection times. We continue to educate and enforce where appropriate. In addition, we are liaising with the Civil Enforcement Team at Malvern Hills District Council to provide further support and ensure these matters are effectively managed.



Kempsey & Alfrick SNT recently hosted a crime prevention event at the Scouts building on Plovers Rise, and we extent out thanks to those who attended. We remain committed to similar initiatives across Kempsey & Alfrick patch delivering safety and security advice. In addition, PCSO Smith is planning to introduce a monthly drop-in surgery for Kempsey, offering scheduled opportunities for residents to engage directly with the team (this does not replace the reporting procedure, as we continue to encourage residents to continue to report incidents through 101/Online or 999 in an emergency). These sessions will be held at varied times, including weekends, and will be publicised in advance. Rest assured, this does not replace visible patrols, and we continue to encourage residents to approach us whenever they see us in the community.

We have begun Neighbourhood Matters surveys across the patch to gather resident's perspectives on crime, safety and security. These surveys are conducted in person at the doorstep and designed to provide valuable insight into local priorities. In the coming weeks, we will focus on completing surveys within Kempsey, targeting areas identified through incident data and community concerns, before expanding to a broader village-wide approach.

The team continued to conduct both foot and mobile patrols in the area (especially areas of concerns following feedback to us, such as The Rocky). We continue to encourage residents to please report incidents to us. Incidents can be reported on 101 or online if they have occurred or are being reported for information purposes. If an act is ongoing where harm could be caused to a person or property, then 999 should always be used.
