**THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (TREE PRESERVATION)(ENGLAND)**  
**REGULATIONS 2012**

**Tree Preservation Order No. 495 (2012) – Holly House, Napleton Lane, Kempsey**

On 15 March 2012 the District Council made the above Tree Preservation Order, and sent you a copy.

The Council has considered whether or not the Order should be Confirmed (or, in other words, made permanent). No representations were made about the Order. On 25 April 2012 the Council decided:

**to Confirm the Order**

The Order was confirmed as the Council consider the trees make a significant contribution to amenity and the local landscape. The effect of the Council's decision is to make Tree Preservation Order No. 495 (2012) permanent. In general terms it is an offence to cut down, lop, top, uproot wilfully damage or destroy a protected tree without the permission of the District Council. Applications for permission to carry out works to protected trees may be submitted in writing to Chris Lewis-Farley, Landscape Officer, Planning Services, The Council House, Avenue Road, Malvern, Worcestershire, WR14 3AF. In submitting an application you should clearly identify which trees you want to carry out work to, what you want to do and why.
