PUBLIC QUESTION TIME

Nancy Morris -

Confirmed that supplementary feeding is affecting the behaviour of the horse/ponies on Kempsey Common. This was demonstrated by ponies circling one of her ewes causing unnecessary distress to the animal. Supplementary feeding should not occur at this time of year.

She also advised that an experienced horse rider fell off her horse as a result of animal behaviour.

Cllr Waller confirmed The Parish Council will proceed on this matter to follow the correct process to endeavour to resolve the problems.

Mrs Morris also returned the by-law sign that needs re-securing to the gate on Common Farm entrance.
