4. The minutes of the meeting held on 08.03.16 having been previously circulated were Approved, and signed as a true and correct record.
5. Rocky Update

The committee decided that following the meeting they would make a site visit to discuss more aesthetic solutions to the flooding damage to the path. Their findings will be put to a full committee, which will be held shortly.
6. Parking at the shop

Councillors were updated on the progress of the agreed signs, which hopefully will be ready shortly.
7. Asset register

Responsibility for the flag pole in the centre of the village has been adopted by the Parish Hall, so should be removed from the register.  
Cllr Blackwell thought that there should be three bus shelters on the list instead of two, and reported that the seat at the Baynhall bus stop needed re-painting.
8. AOB
  - a). If the lengthsman is in agreement, the new grassed verge just north of the shop should be added to his list of areas for mowing.
  - b). Cllr Blackwell proposed that a new bin should be installed by the side of the Bob Bullock Memorial Bench at the Rocky. Before installation the Parish Council must ask MHDC if they will agree to empty it on a weekly basis. The current bin was temporarily installed by the Church, and is emptied by Cllr Blackwell.
  - c). Cllr Blackwell proposed that we change the metal bins for plastic ones as and when needed.
  - d). Cllr Pugh reported that the lane at Kerswell Greens had become very overgrown, but after being reported to WCC Highways had cut the verges, but had told a resident that they were not responsible for the ditches and runnels. Cllr Pugh will ask Teal Turf to the necessary remedial work.
