



**MINUTES OF THE RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON

1. Cllr Fraser-Cann was appointed as Committee Chairman

4. Minutes: The minutes of the Recreation Committee Meeting of 26.04.16 having been previously circulated, were signed as a true and correct record.
5. Cllr Fraser-Cann updated the Committee on the work required to repair the pavilion roof. A specialist contractor had been to investigate the problems with the edges and corners, and would in due course prepare a report making recommendations as to what remedial work should be undertaken. The inside roof space had been examined, and everything looked good except a little water egress in the corners  
 It was also noted that there was also a problem around the roof lights, and it was thought that the flashing had probably degraded. These were last maintained approximately 10 years ago. This work would be added to the specification for the larger roof repairs.
6. Cllr Fraser- Cann updated the Committee on the Playsafe Inspection Report. There is moss on some of the flooring on the children's playground, and the spinner on the other side of the playing field needs a new bearing. It had been suggested that we should replace the entire spinner, but Cllrs Fraser-Cann and Geens felt that a local engineering company would be able to make a good safe repair. Cllr Hodgkins reported that some of the ball-stop netting was loose Cllr Geens
7. It was felt that as there were showers in the pavilion a Legionella Inspection/Test should be undertaken. Cllr Fraser- Cann will check the regulations covering this matter and obtain quotes for such tests if they are due.
8. The relevant section of the Asset Register was examined, and found to be in order with no amendments necessary.
9. Any Other Business
  - a). Cllr Geens reported that the cricket club had asked for additional Ball-Stop fencing to prevent balls going into the children's playground. Cllr Geens will liaise with KSA.
