1. The Committee Task List was reviewed and updated. Action required was identified.
2. The graffiti at the Rocky was discussed and it was identified that the remaining graffiti, which is on the walls of the road bridge, is on County Council property and the County Council has already been made aware of this. The action was to make a proposal to the full council to appoint the Duckworth Trust to remove the graffiti from the bus shelters, Pavilion and Youth Centre.
3. The fallen tree in the Rocky is to be incorporated in the tree inspection survey (Wade Muggleton).
4. Rocky Improvement Project. Update provided in the task list. To identify whether the Environment Agency still requires us to pay the £5,000 allocated for the flood defence.
5. The final discussion was that the best place to locate the bin would be next to the Pavillion, where the current bin is located. However, it was acknowledge that MHDC would not empty the bin from this location. There was discussion about whether to get one of the new bins installed by the Pavillion (to replace the existing one) but the sports association would still be responsible for emptying it. This was referred back to the Recreation Committee to liaise with Bob Stokes.
6. The Budget for 2013/14 was prepared. This included a forecast for 2014/15 and 2015/16
