7. Fencing along the southern boundary. Cllr Campbell to pursue. A letter is to be devised and issued to Mr Williams to seek permission to access his land whilst fencing works are carried out.

8. Clearing of the rubble and soil from the south east corner of the field. Clerk to request a start date from Anstey & Sons

9. Removal of dog waste from bins on the playing field – To amalgamate this item the Pavilion Caretaker's Contract of employment. (Cllr Gerrard to update Cllr Hay)

10. Removal of over growth from behind the Community Youth Centre. Cllr Stevens to devise a specification to include cut, treat and remove brambles off site. The Clerk to issue to contractors to obtain quotations.
