1. The list of projects was reviewed and updated. Cllr Stevens declared an Other Disclosable Interest during the discussion concerning the installation of the football goals.
2. Driveway Repairs – Cllr Patrick is to attend a site meeting with the Contract Manager from Worcester County Council to obtain a quote.
3. Maintenance on trees in tree line and further tree in hedge line and letters to neighbouring properties – The item was to discuss the trees in tree line that are on either side of the drive up to the playing field. Advice has been obtained from MHDC and it has been recommended to us that we do some maintenance work on them. We will be seeking comments from the neighbouring properties in connection with this.  
The further tree in the hedge line is one in the southern boundary (the one that adjoins Mr Williams field). This tree has a branch that is growing out into the playing field and the Sports Association would like it removed to reduce the leaf fall onto the playing field and also to reduce the shadow it casts in the low winter sun.
4. Removal of rubbish and soil in SE corner of the playing field – Two quotes have been received. A further one is to be obtained.
5. Painting of Go-Stores – A letter is to be issued to the Sports Association asking if they would liaise with the owner to carry out some maintenance work to the Go Stores i.e. paint one colour by August 2013.
6. The Budget for 2013/14 was devised. An increase in expenditure is indicated in Pavilion Works/Inspection to allow provision to modify the existing doors or replace and for the installation of emergency lighting.
