NOTICE OF THE CLOSURE OF C2220 SQUIRES WALK AND U60018 CHURCH STREET, KEMPSEY, WORCESTERSHIRE

Reason for restriction: Burst water main. There is a likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road. There is a need to close the highway in the following terms:-

1. The effect of this Notice is that no vehicle shall proceed along that part of
1: U60017 Squires Walk from its junction with U60018 Church Street for a distance of 28 metres in a southerly direction
2: U60018 Church Street from its junction with U60017 Squires Walk for a distance of 25 metres in an easterly direction.
2. This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 21 days: however, it is anticipated that it will remain in force for 3 days (24hrs) commencing 16 June 2026.
3. Alternative routes: U60021 Chapel Road, U60020 Lyfs Lane and vice versa.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
